Thrush


Thrush is a fungus and/or bacterial infection that grows in wet living conditions.

- Get horses out of the mud!!!!! (and usually manure)
- Soak horses feet. See soaking a horses foot.
- Apply Pete's goo to the frog area of the hoof once or twice a day. Make sure to get it down deep.

Pete's Goo:

- 1 oz Clotrimazole (athletes foot cream) mixed with 1 oz triple antibiotic (Neosporin)
- Put this mixture in a syringe with a tip so you can push it into the holes and small groves of the horses foot that is infected with thrush.
- Ride horse with hoof boots until the new frog has grown back.







After
